**Benchmarking Service**

In recent years, many social work programs have felt increasing pressure from their institutions to provide data comparing their program to "peer institutions." While CSWE has long provided program-level data about the number of enrolled students, graduates, and faculty members, much of the data submitted in the Annual Survey have only been reported in aggregate format. In order to be responsive to the needs of our program members, we started a benchmarking service.

The benchmarking service uses key questions already being asked in the Annual Survey and new questions. **The questions were identified by the NADD Benchmarking Committee**, which included members of BPD and GADE. Programs that agree to participate in the benchmarking project will receive a specialized report with the results of the benchmarking questions. In addition, they will be eligible to request an individualized report comparing their results to the benchmarking questions to those of program-identified peer institutions. The individualized reports will have a small fee attached to cover CSWE staff time in preparing the report. Programs can participate in the benchmarking project without requesting the individualized reports.

CSWE will always protect confidential information submitted by programs, so individual faculty member salaries will never be given out to other programs. Salary information will be reported in aggregate and not reported when less than five faculty members are in a single category.
