The Council on Social Work Education (CSWE) Katherine A. Kendall Institute for International Social Work Education (KAKI) Advisory Board invites applications for new member candidates.

KAKI was established in 2004 to help prepare educators, researchers, students, and practitioners for an increasingly global community. Dr. Kendall created an endowment to support KAKI's activities and initiatives. Since its founding, KAKI has held numerous panels, conferences, and workshops addressing such topics as disaster management, migration, and human rights. Additionally, KAKI has developed a resource manual, social work faculty fellowships for international scholars, and a grant program to fund international social work activities.

The programmatic policy-making body for KAKI is the Advisory Board. Members oversee KAKI's funds and initiatives. The Board is comprised of experts from the international social work community and representatives from partnerships including the International Association of Schools of Social Work (IASSW) and the North American and Caribbean Association of Schools of Social Work.

KAKI is looking for three new Advisory Board members to serve terms that vary between 2 and 3 years. The work of the Board is usually conducted by conference calls plus a face-to-face meeting at the CSWE Annual Program Meeting. Applicants must be members of CSWE and should have some of the following background:

- Experience working with international organizations and foundations (IASSW, International Federation of Social Workers, International Council on Social Welfare, United Nations, etc.)
- Previous membership on boards, as committee chairs, or on commissions or councils (e.g., with the Association of Baccalaureate Social Work Program Directors, National Association of Deans and Directors of Schools of Social Work, or CSWE)
- Extensive work experience (10+ years) in international social work and promoting international social work education and initiatives
- Experience working in environment and sustainability issues, human rights, migration, and disaster management
- Experience overseeing fellowships and grant programs
- Strong international networks and partnerships
