¹ At the same institution, the baccalaureate and master's program directors may be the same person until 30-days before the candidacy 1 visit. Therefore, the program director indicated on the application may temporarily be the same for both program levels. However, for staff to approve the Benchmark 1 document and enter Pre-candidacy, programs must have documented that a separate program director is formally hired, with a start date no later than 30-days before the visit date (i.e., when the Benchmark document is sent to the visitor and program's accreditation specialist). For Benchmark 1, programs must have a program director actively working within the program 30-days before the visit date (i.e., when the Benchmark document is sent to the visitor and program's accreditation specialist) are not enrolled or the program is not fully operational.
